Managing Occupational Safety and Health Workshop



Managers and supervisors are key personnel in every workplace. They need a range of skills in order to effectively manage safety in the workplace.

Essential knowledge and skills covered in this course include legislative requirements and responsibilities, safety management systems, risk assessment techniques, accident/incident investigation, workplace inspections and an overview of the behavioural approach to safety.

This program equips each participant with the knowledge and skills to effectively implement and supervise a workplace risk management program. Skills are developed via practical, interactive activities designed to relate to actual workplace situations.

Content

- legislative requirements and responsibilities for OSH in the workplace
- hazard identification and control
- developing and implementing safety management systems
- risk assessment skills and techniques
- job safety analysis and procedure development
- accident/incident investigation and workplace inspection skills
- auditing the workplace and action planning
- safety leadership in the workplace

Managers, workplace supervisors and any staff members who may be considered for future leadership roles within the organisation.
