OSH Harmonisation - Training to get your business up to speed

The latest model of the harmonised OSH legislation will soon be released by Safe Work Australia, bringing with it new rules, regulations and penalties that WA business must address. The new legislation will create new and increased duties, broaden the scope of responsibilities and coverage and create a more rigid and prescriptive compliance regime. Business must prepare for the changes and take practical steps to ensure that their workplace is ready.

The CCI OSH team has partnered with CCI Business Training in order to address how the new harmonised system of OSH laws will impact directly on WA business.

Executive Boardroom Briefings

Company officers, executives, senior managers and business owners will have an increased scope of duties for ensuring a safe workplace under new harmonised OSH legislation. Among these will be the duty to demonstrate personal due diligence in the management of risks in the workplace and an understanding of the new legislation. People with decision making powers within an organisation will be subject to more rigorous examination of their actions in the event of a workplace incident. A breach of the new duty of care can result in vastly increased penalties and personal liability.

This high level Boardroom Briefing will address the needs of business owners, company executives and senior managers in understanding the new legislative provisions. The briefing will cover the scope, application and interpretation of officer duties, as well as providing an overview of the intent in the drafting of these provisions.

The Briefing will be delivered by Anne Bellamy, CCI's Manager Safety and Social Policy and an industry representative on the Safe Work Australia Council.

Is your business in tune with the harmonised OSH laws?

A new harmonised system of OSH laws around Australia will impact directly on business in WA. The new legislation will create new and increased duties, broaden the scope of responsibilities and coverage and create a more rigid and prescriptive compliance regime. Business must prepare for the changes and take practical steps to ensure that their workplace is ready.

This workshop is designed for people with responsibilities for coordinating and managing OSH in the workplace. It will cover the provisions of the legislation which are likely to require the most attention from employers and provide practical advice for implementing changes in the workplace.
