### Shell's Prelude FLNG Project

Shell's Prelude FLNG Project has started listing procurement opportunities on ProjectConnect. Shell is currently in Front End Engineering and Design for the Prelude FLNG Project located offshore some 475 km NNE of Broome off the Kimberley coast of Western Australia.

## Will skill shortages put Mining Safety at risk?



Contracting and executive recruitment firm Wilson People Management (WPM) has seen major changes in requirements for technical and operational professionals (including OHS professionals) in the resource industry. This is due to the increasing trend for personnel from the metallurgical mining industry to make the move to oil and gas in pursuit of better pay and working conditions.

In the past, these companies were firm in the belief that they would not take on people from the mining industry but now because of mega projects like that of the Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Gorgon project in WA, safety officers and other technical staff are making a move in unprecedented numbers.

“Skilled workers from mining and other sectors are willing to make the change to LNG for the pay rise and project sustainability,” said WPM Managing Director Ben Wilson. For the other projects this means a shortage of safety officers; which have to be sourced from elsewhere.

From a salary perspective the people coming from mining industries are finding both financial and lifestyle rewards in changing employers. To compete, companies are willing to pay up to ten percent more to make the switch. As would be expected there is a safety up skill requirement in the transition process to make up for the difference in two industries and different technologies.

Mega-projects like Gorgon are applying strict OHS policies to ensure that all workers meet the safety standards set by the Oil and Gas industry. This up-skilling ensures that companies, contractors and site personnel are compliant with legislative requirements in place in the Oil & Gas industry, such as the SafetyMap framework.

Not only are these mega projects sourcing technical and operational employees from the mining industry, but are back-filling positions with candidates from overseas markets and looking to new sectors and disciplines such as engineering to fill the void that these large scale projects create.

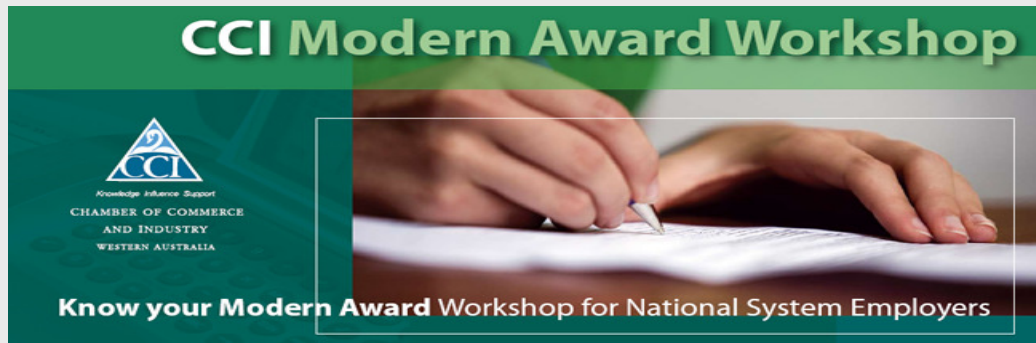

From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 the majority of employees' terms and conditions come from a new Modern Award and the National Employment Standard.

For many businesses, the modern awards contain new allowances, hours of work, and penalty provisions and are subject to complicated transitional arrangements. An employer who doesn't comply with their modern award can be fined up to \$33, 000 per breach.
