



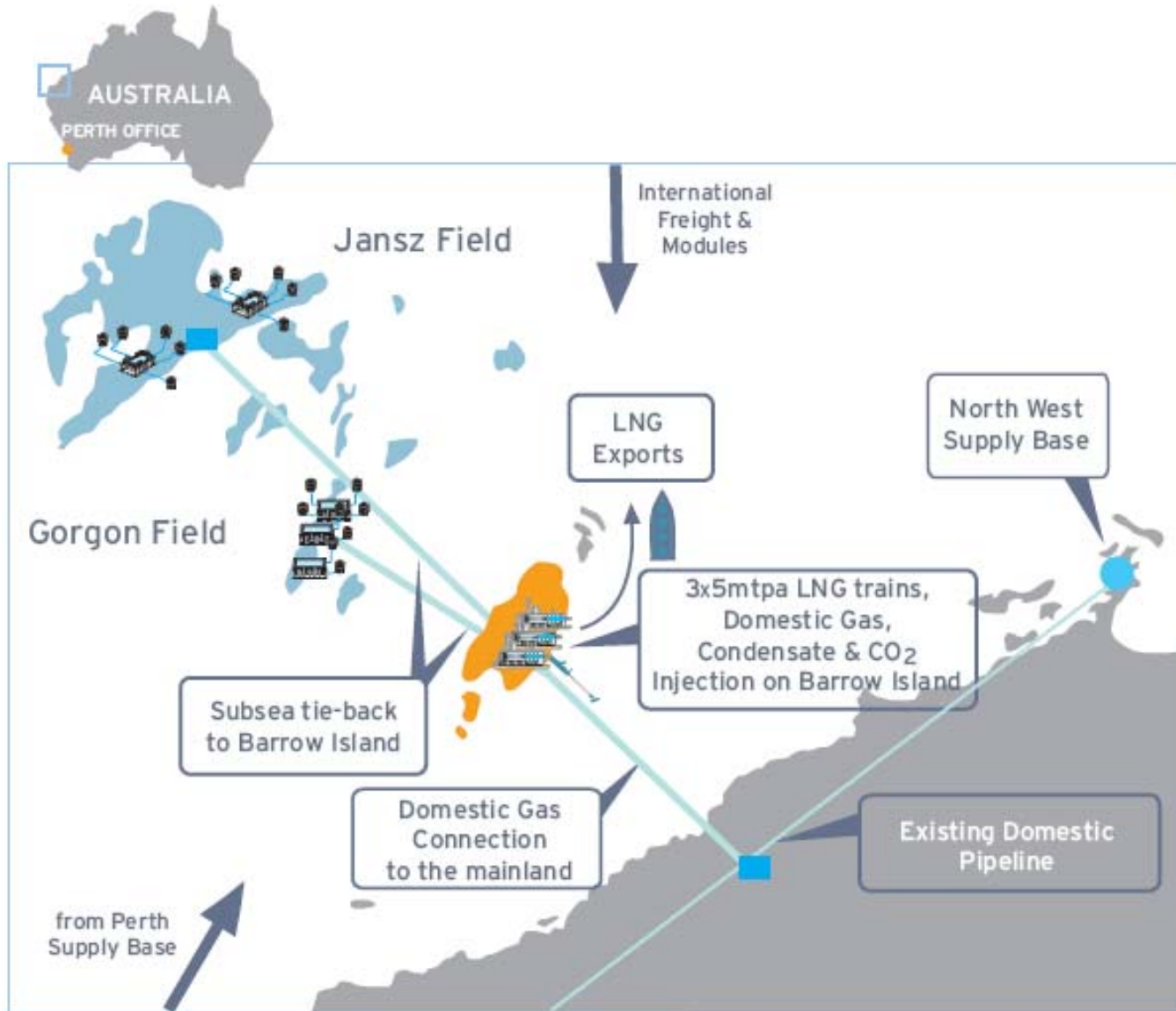

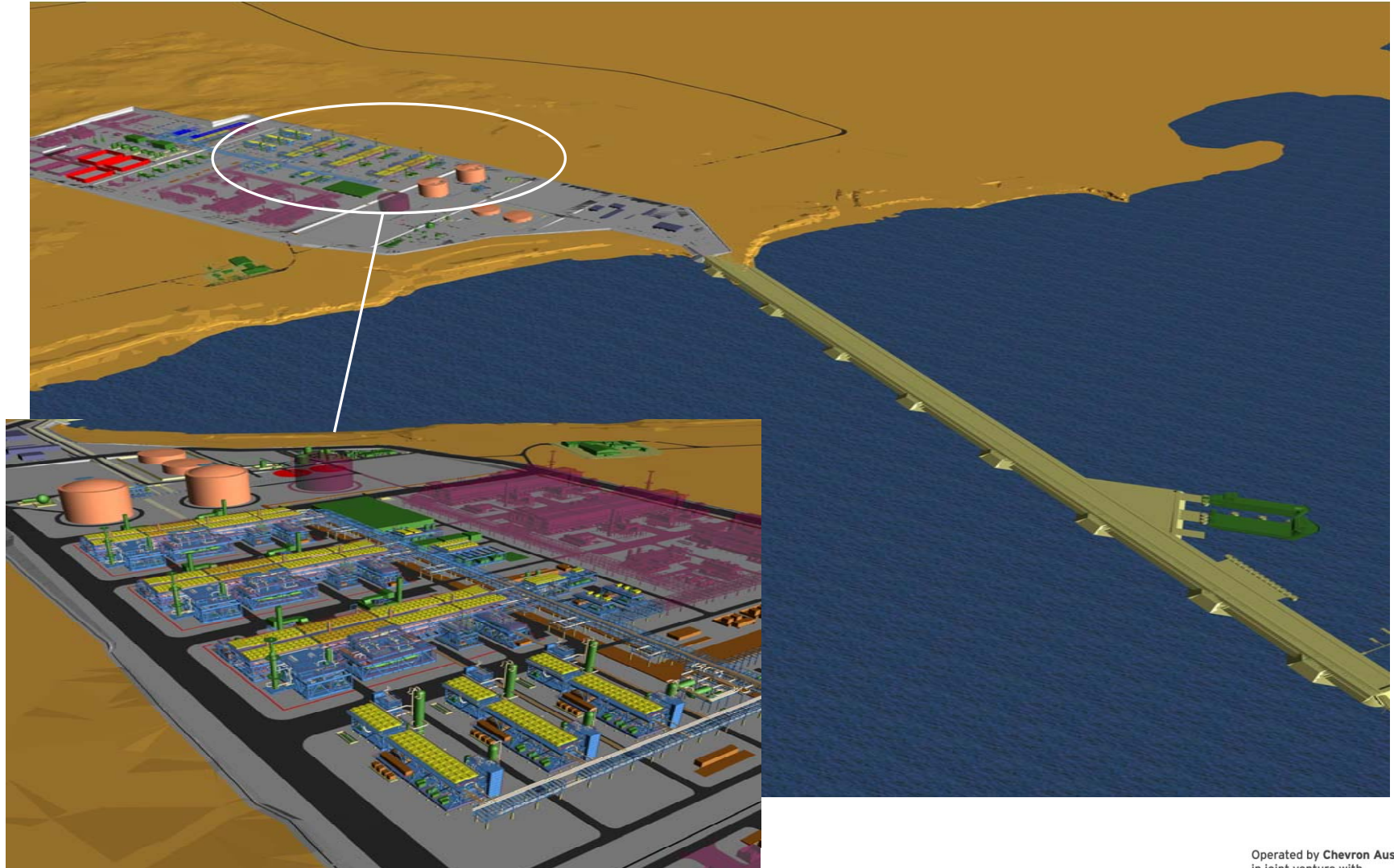

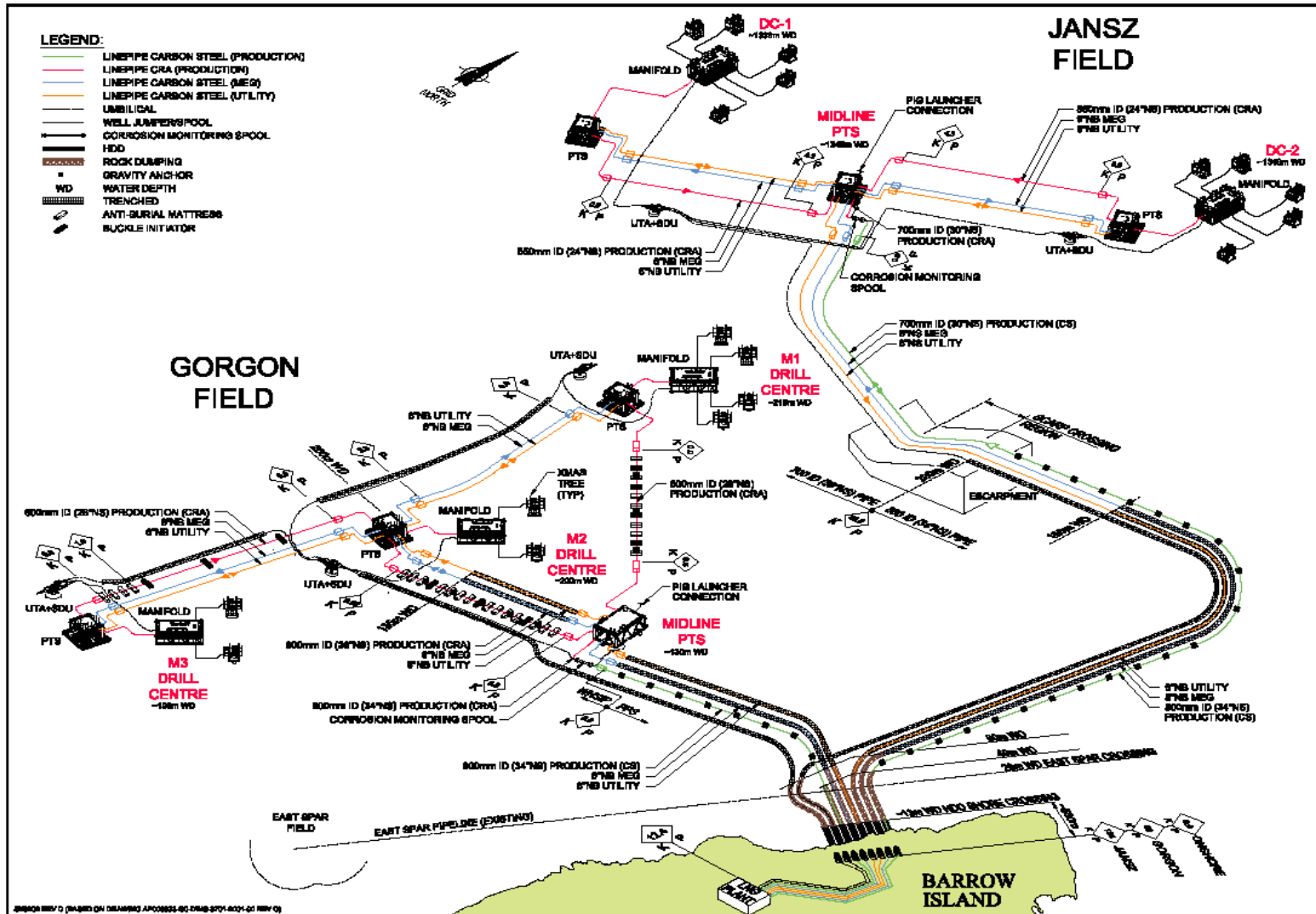

Proposed Upstream packages

- Pre-lay scarp crossing excavation
- Onshore pipeline & control component installation
- HDD shore crossing installation
- Shallow & Deep water pipeline installation
- DomGas pipeline and related facilities construction
- Gravity anchor installation
- Offshore umbilical installation (& post-lay trenching)
- Post-lay trenching (pipelines)
- Heavy lift structures and spools / Subsea tie-ins
- Rock dumping
- Rock Supply / Marine Load-out Facility
- Pre-commissioning activities (onshore & marine support)
